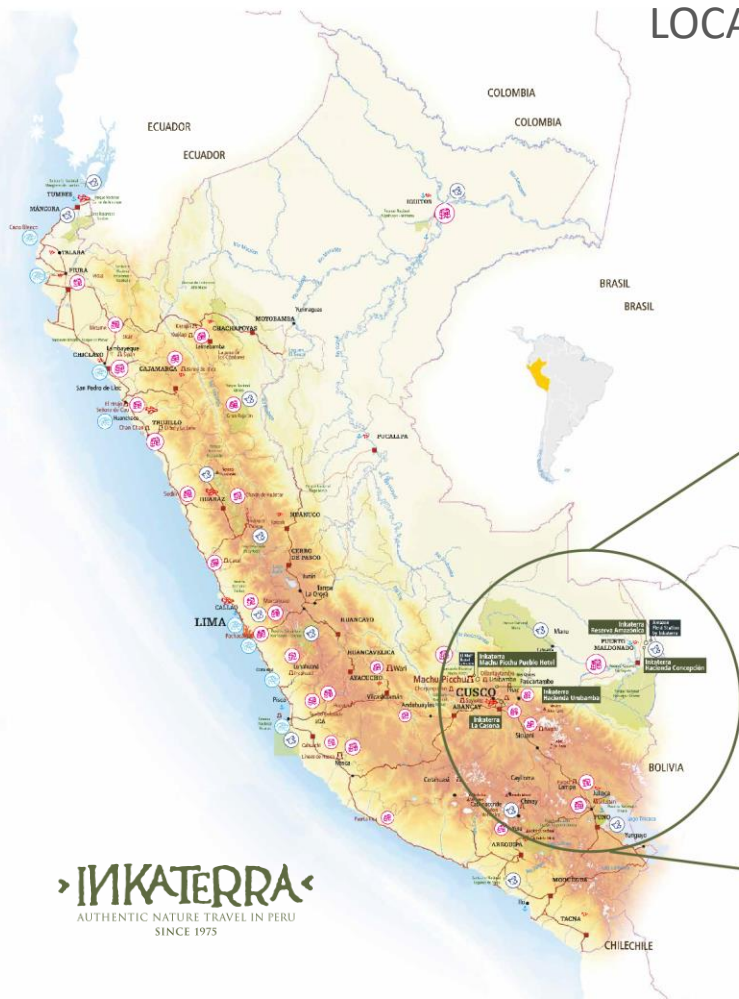

Remote, yet accessible by canoe, Inkaterra Reserva Amazonica is located on Peru's meandering Madre de Dios River. Ecotourism activities are based on research for nature conservation, including the Inkaterra Canopy Walkway and birdwatching excursions to spot many of the 540 bird species registered within property.

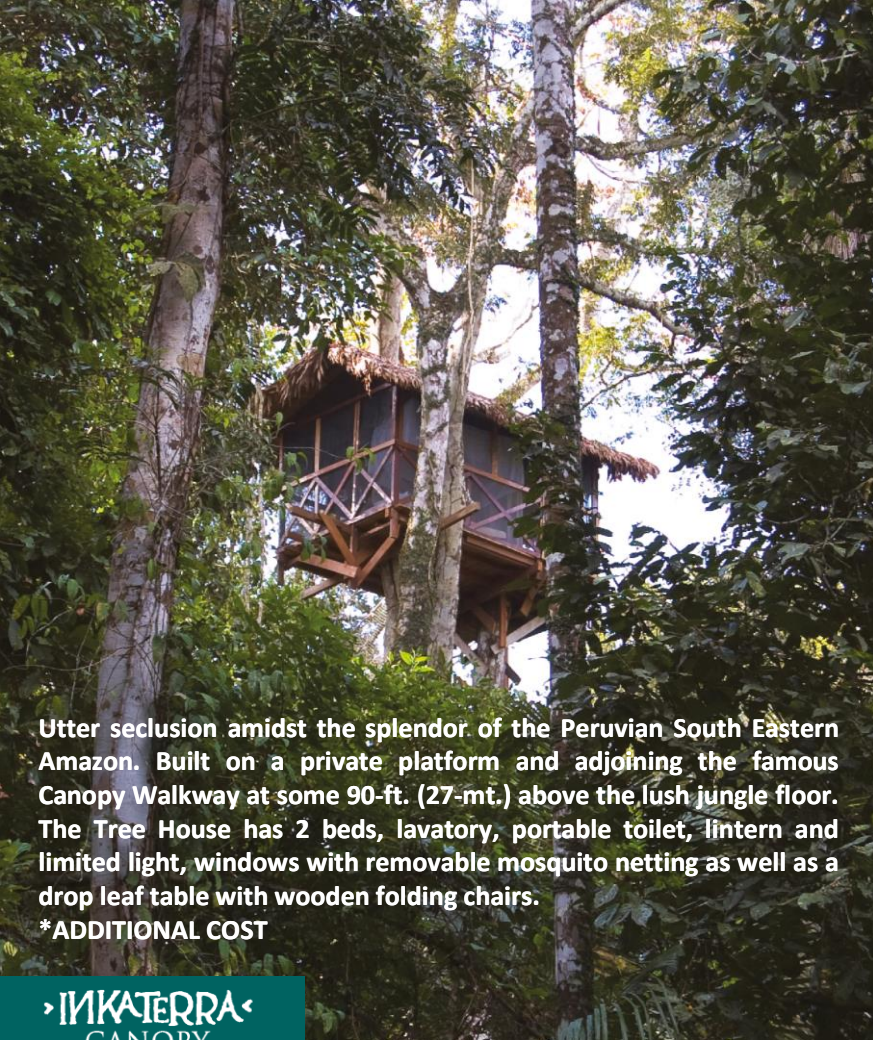

Utter seclusion amidst the splendor of the Peruvian South Eastern Amazon. Built on a private platform and adjoining the famous Canopy Walkway at some 90-ft. (27-mt.) above the lush jungle floor. The Tree House has 2 beds, lavatory, portable toilet, lantern and limited light, windows with removable mosquito netting as well as a drop leaf table with wooden folding chairs.

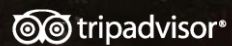

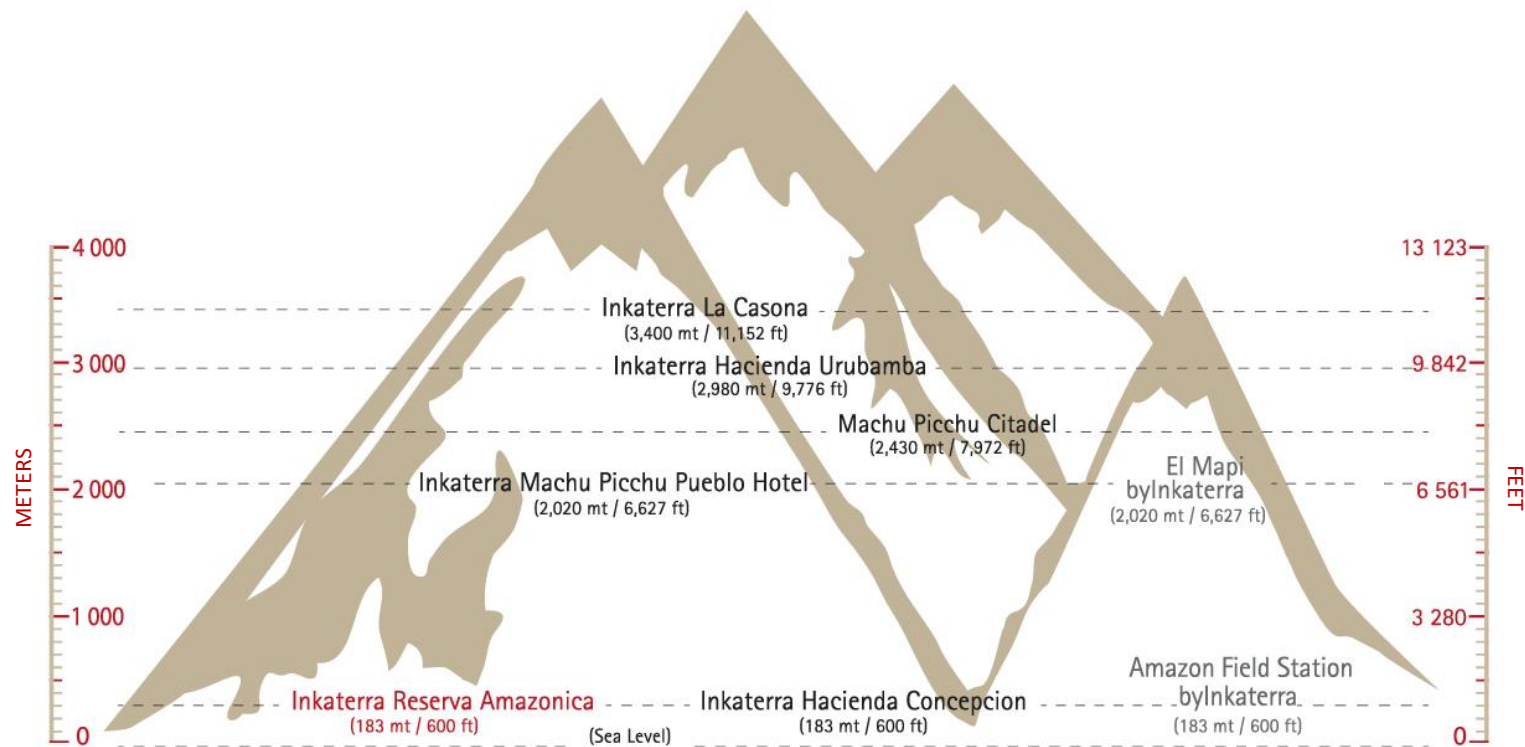

Self-financed via ecotourism, NGO Inkaterra Asociación (ITA) performs scientific research since 1978 to define natural areas where Inkaterra hotels are established.

Inventories on flora and fauna set a benchmark to compare the brand's future impact. A total of 814 bird species, 365 ant species (world record sponsored by Harvard Professor E.O. Wilson), 313 butterfly species, 100 mammal species and 1266 vascular plant species have been registered within hotel grounds and surroundings, as 28 species new to science have been described: 20 orchids, 5 amphibians, 1 butterfly, 2 bromeliads and 1 tropical vine.
